### TASTING NOTES

Baking spices, raspberries and violet aromas are met with wild berries, ripe dark fruits and black cherries on the palate. Medium body with a sweet mid-palate gives this wine great length and polished tannins. Pairs well with your Fall favorite stews and brick oven pizzas.

### APPELLATION

#### SANGIACOMO VINEYARD (ROBERT'S ROAD)

First planted in 1998 to the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay varieties, Sangiacomo Roberts Road is bordered on the northern edge by Copeland Creek and consists of 14 different clone and rootstock combinations. Along neighboring Gap's Crown (located across the street) Sangiacomo Roberts Road has become the benchmark for Sonoma Coast cult Pinot Noir. Cool, coastal morning fog and wind burn away to warm afternoon sun. Its rocky soil northern edge bordered by Copeland Creek creates a strenuous growing environment for the vines, producing structure and richness in the fruit.

### VINTAGE

2015 was one of the best vintages California has seen. An early start in the Spring meant an early finish in the Fall. Warm days and cool nights – near perfect conditions!
